

Fulfilling the Mission of Revelation 8:13

“And I beheld, and heard an angel flying through the midst of heaven, saying with a loud voice, Woe, woe, woe, to the inhabitants of the earth by reason of the other voices of the trumpet of the three angels, which are yet to sound!” Rev. 8:13.

This loud-voiced angel is to unite its message with the messages of the three angels of Revelation 14. It is this angel that is referred to by the phrase: “And I saw *another angel* fly in the midst of heaven, having the everlasting gospel . . .” Rev. 14:6.

“... a wonderful impetus was given to the advent movement” (GC 335) when the message of the woes was connected with the first and second angel’s messages back in the 1840s. Connecting the third woe with the third angel’s message will do the same today.

The evangelistic meetings of our pioneers presented the woes with the three angel’s messages, fulfilling the mission of the angel of Revelation 8:13.
